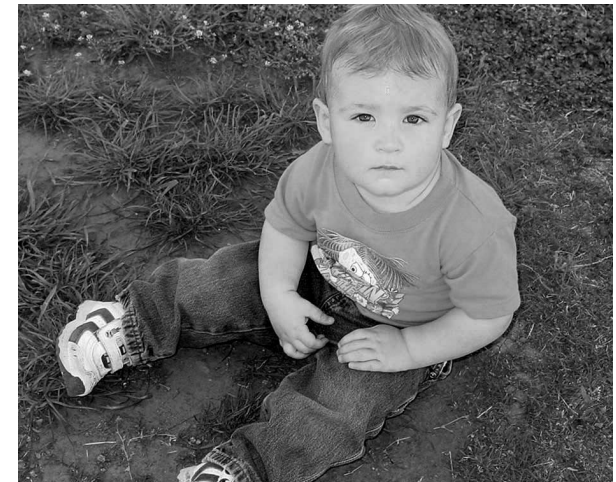

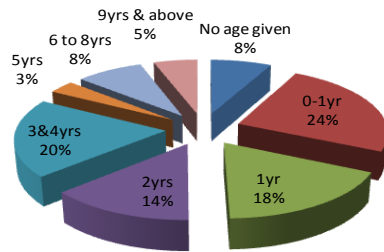


# 2007–2008 ANNUAL REPORT

*Delaware Child Development is under the supervision and direction of the Washington Child Care Foundation.*

## SERVICES TO FAMILIES:

From July 2007 until June 2008, Delaware Child Development Resource and Referral received 438 calls from families seeking assistance locating childcare.

## SERVICES TO PROVIDERS:

Training and technical assistance was available to all of the 454 providers in the nine county service area during FY2008. Delaware Child Development Resource and Referral staff presented 33 trainings, providing 58 hours of training to 269 attendees. In addition, they facilitated 53 trainings, making possible an additional 158 hours of training with 664 in attendance. When added together, facilitated and provided trainings totaled 86 trainings, which provided 216 hours of training and 933 in attendance.

Technical assistance was redefined in FY2008. This resulted in a decline in technical assistance numbers and a comparable rise in provider assisted calls. Technical assistance calls for the year totaled 452 and email technical assistance logged totaled 226. Providers received assistance at R&R offices 68 times during the year and at the provider site 104 times. In addition, there were 243 provider visits to R&R resource rooms located in Bartlesville, Ponca City and Stillwater. R&R Specialists assisted new and expanding providers 41 times during the year.\* Other services rendered to providers included resource lending libraries at each of three sites, bi-monthly newsletters, and referrals for services.

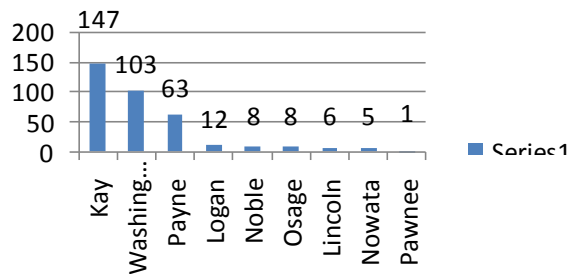
## COMMUNITY SERVICES:

In FY2008, Resource & Referral Specialists advocated and promoted child care issues through collaborative efforts with physicians, local health departments, DHS workers, businesses, schools and a great variety of community agencies involved with early childhood issues.

Resource and Referral Specialists distributed more than 1,000 informational flyers on R&R services and early childhood development issues to DHS offices, health departments, community agencies, schools and physicians offices across the service delivery area. Lending libraries were made available to the public at all three sites, offering resources for parents, providers and the community.

Events sponsored in fiscal year 2007 included a poverty simulation. Provider Palooza, informational booths with on-site referrals, presentations of services, a child care conference, and college enrollment nights. Delaware Child Development also brought in Bill Millett, an economist who presented as well as met with community members in Bartlesville, Ponca City and Stillwater to share his knowledge on economics and early childhood.
